PROUD 2B AN ORGAN DONOR

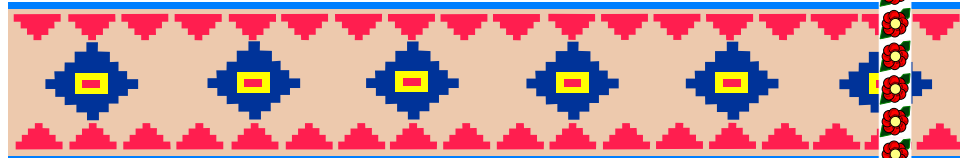
