Parents are requested to go to families, businesses in the area of your work, home, shopping centre, to request donations, prizes, hampers, vouchers, etc. (You will need a letter from the school, giving you authority to collect prizes on behalf of the school).

Bring your unwanted books (in good condition), (NO MAGAZINES), as well as your empty garden pots and seedling trays (these needed urgently, to plant seedlings) Unwanted plants will also be welcome. White elephant items e.g. crockery, pots, pans, pictures, vases, appliances in working order, ANYTHING we can sell on the day
