**We need prizes and items for:** bottle stall, (place items into an empty bottle, e.g. cotton wool, ear buds, biscuits, small toys etc) as well as bottles of wine, olives, preserves, juice, bath salt, etc, that we can use as prizes.

**Prizes are needed** for the money-or- the-box and fishing stalls.

**We need donations** of roti & mince, samoosas, breyani, curry, burgers, hot dogs, sauces, rolls, ingredients, fillings, plant stall, Cakes, sweets. cakes, teas, coffees, etc.

**CARE CENTRE**

Please note that should your monthly fees not be paid by the 6<sup>th</sup> of each month, we will not allow your child/ren to attend the Care Centre, as from the 7<sup>th</sup> day of that month.

**PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES BY DEBIT ORDER**

Parents who wish to pay school fees by Debit Order may get their Debit Order form from the Bursar’s office or can receive the form via email, by requesting it from [accounts@fdrs.school.co.za](mailto:accounts@fdrs.school.co.za).
