FDR FÊTE - SATURDAY 30 MAY

10 days to go

The countdown has begun. Our fête will be taking place next week Saturday.

It is not too late to support us.

We appeal to parents to support this event. There are several ways you can get involved:

FROM HOME:

- Bring your unwanted **books** (in good condition), (NO MAGAZINES),
- Gardening stall: donations of plants, compost, garden accessories, monetary donations towards purchasing plants for the stall.
- Second hand items: clothing, (in good condition) crafts, toys, jewellery, crockery, pots, pans, pictures, vases, appliances in working order, home décor, bedding; ANYTHING we can sell on the day will be welcomed!
- Bottle stall, anything in a bottle (place items into an empty bottle, e.g. cotton wool, ear buds, biscuits, small toys etc) as well as bottles of wine, unopened presents, olives, preserves, juice, bath salt, etc, that we can use as prizes.

FROM HOME, SHOPS, COMPANIES, SPONSORS

- **Prizes are needed** for the money-or- the-box and fishing stalls. Prizes can consist of anything new, or unused items.
- **Gifts for prizes and raffles** (hampers, vouchers of any kind, a week-end away, a meal at a restaurant etc).
- **Cakes for the tea garden, home made or bought.**

Donations and items for the fête can be dropped off at the office.

MOST IMPORTANT: BUY A BRACELET FOR YOUR CHILDREN

Bring your children, your nieces, nephews, neighbours' children with you and let them be occupied for the whole morning at the Funfair. *In order for them to participate on the fun rides, you will need to buy a bracelet at a cost of R70. This will enable the child to go on as many rides throughout the day. This is a bargain! (if you go to amusement parks, one can pay up to R15 per ride). Learners can pay for their bracelets to their class teacher.*

PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES BY DEBIT ORDER

Parents who wish to pay school fees by Debit Order may get their Debit Order form from the Bursar's office or can receive the form via email, by requesting it from accounts@fdrschooll.co.za. There is a saving of R20 per child per month using this method. i.e. R220 if using this method of payment for the full year (11x months).
